Retreat Theme: Senex and Puer

Are men maturing later these days? Is there a fear of risk or commitment? Is there a part of us that doesn't want to grow up? **Puer** Aeturnus or Eternal Boy is the Romans' word for this guy. As the Wikipedia editors nicely put it:

"The puer typically leads a provisional life, due to the fear of being caught in a situation from which it might not be possible to escape. He covets independence and freedom, chafes at boundaries and limits, and tends to find any restriction intolerable." The puer (poo-air) is creative but may never realize his vision.

The puer archetype is defined by the behaviors of spontaneity, impulsiveness, enthusiasm or mania, flashes of insight, and a thriving on fantasy and creativity.

Senex, the old man, stands for the "disciplined, controlled, responsible, rational, ordered". The senex consolidates, grounds, and disciplines. Senex may be a wise man. He may be a wizard. But he may have a negative side which can be cold, depressed, and with a tendency to clog intellectual plumbing, and prevent the flow of fresh thought. He may be the devouring father or a doddering fool.

King's Arrow Ranch, Hillsdale, MS, just east of I-59 North at exit 35, 75 miles north of New Orleans and 30 miles south of Hattiesburg, MS.
